



## General Expectations for Remote Learning

- Each day will start at 8:20 - students should log on to their advisory
- Attendance will be taken in advisory each day, so being on time is important
- We will not have electives on December 17th
  - 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade students, please use the time to set up your learning space.
- Zoom Links for classes will be posted in each of your Google classes.
- We will follow the regular school day schedule; today, December 17th is a “B” day, (Afternoon classes)
- We will not have a breakfast call next week
- Lunch/recess/study hall are breaks for students and planning periods for teachers - no need to log on
- Students must wear their Link gym shirt or Link polo shirt while logged on to class. A Link sweatshirt is also acceptable, but not the hoodie. If you are out of uniform, email Dean DeNully to explain why you are out of uniform.
- Set up your home “learning center”
  - Find a quiet place in your home that you can consistently use from about 8:15 to 4:00 pm.
  - Keep the background simple
  - Keep all of your school supplies together and in a safe place
  - School Chromebooks must be used for school work by Link scholars only
  - Link Chromebooks are NOT for siblings or other family members.
  - The acceptable use policy extends to home so ONLY appropriate school websites should be visited.

## Expectations on Zoom Calls

- Links MUST NOT be shared with anyone outside of our community
- Be on time to all of your classes
- Cameras must be on and your face from your chin to the top of your head should be in full frame
- Work hard and follow directions of your teachers - always practice the core values
- Your cell phones MAY NOT be on while you are in class
- No videos/pictures should be taken while on the call
- Be mindful of your background and distractions
- Submit all assignments ON TIME
- Remember that you have a lot of support: Dean DeNully, Mrs. Dandie-Lashley and Mrs. Acevedo, Nurse Hannah, Ms. Hester, Mrs. Kennedy and all of your teachers are here for you. Please reach out to any of us to support you.
- Be sure to treat your technology correctly. Don't over charge it, DO NOT eat or drink around your Chromebook. Keep your Chromebook in a safe location while you're working on schoolwork, or when it is off. Be sure that it is someplace where it cannot fall onto the floor and break.
