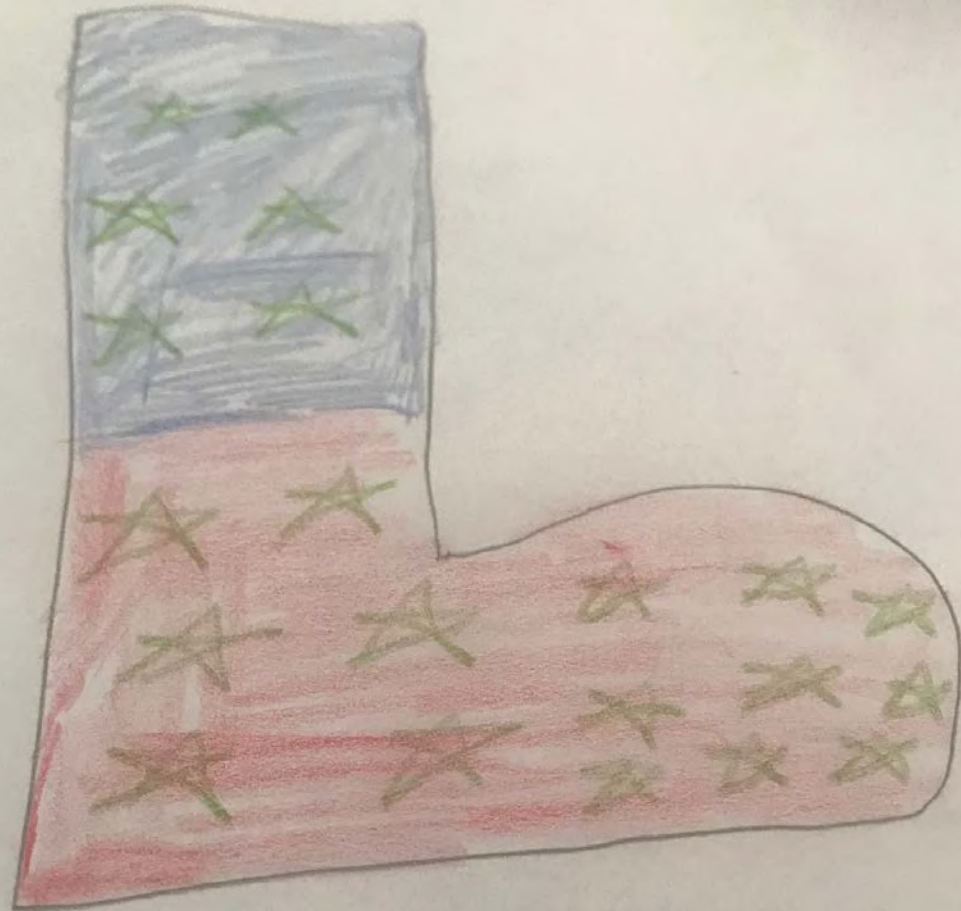

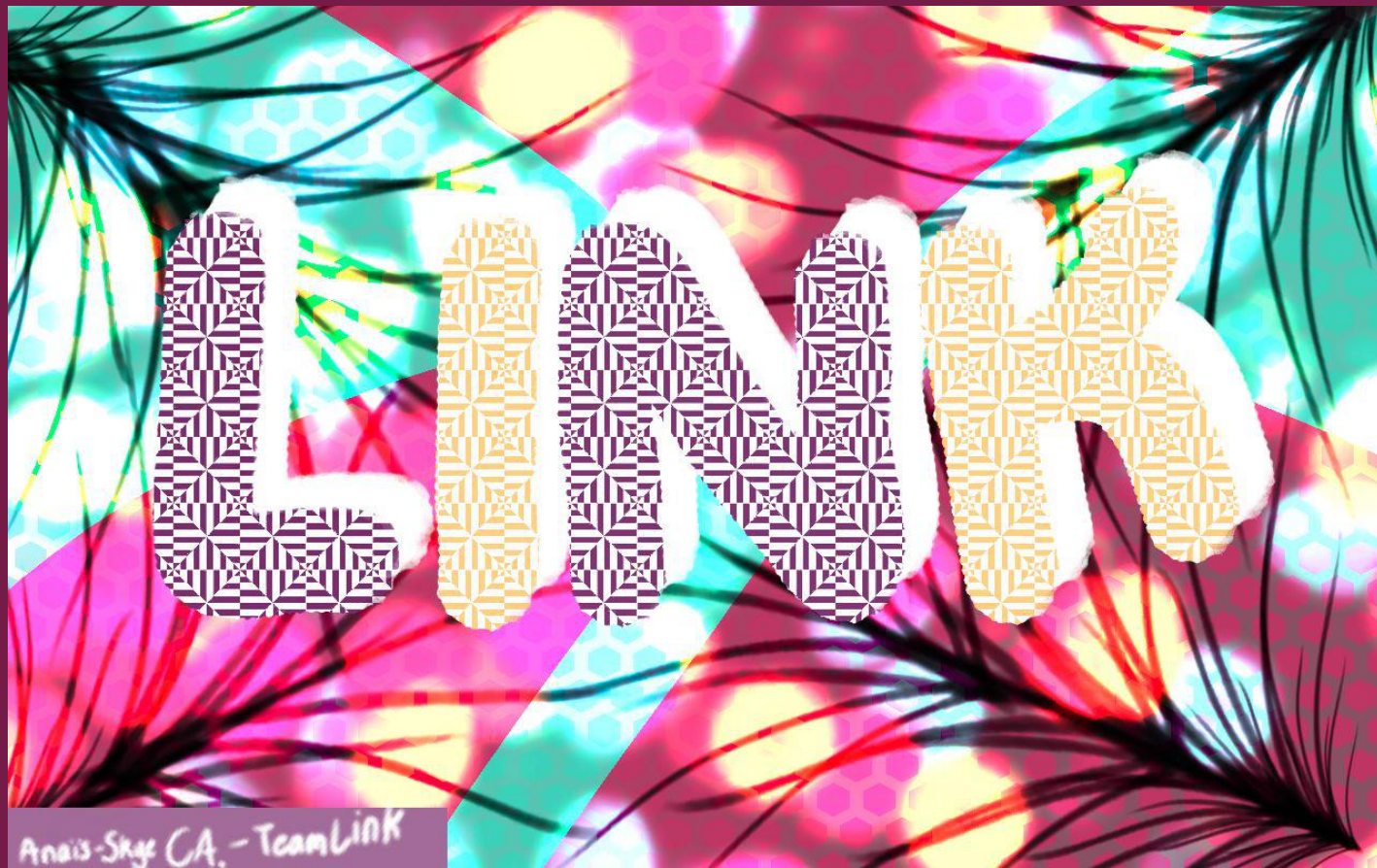
Scholars created a logo design using warm and cool colors.
