

All are welcome! But if you have COVID-19, you can spread the virus. If we work together, we can keep our community safe.

Entry Procedures for All (Students, Staff, Families, Visitors)

1. Sanitize hands.
2. Wear a mask if you feel more comfortable (masks optional).
3. Use good judgment about COVID, Flu-like, or other illness symptoms. Do not enter the school building if experiencing a fever or have experienced a fever in the past 24 hours with or without medication.



Voluntary, FREE, On-site COVID-19 Testing for Students and Staff Experiencing Symptoms

1. Over the Counter Tests are available to all staff and students as needed.
2. Limited test kits are also available for staff and student families.

Testing Results (specific circumstances may require some variation)

1. If test NEGATIVE for COVID-19, after exposure or some symptoms, you can end your isolation after receiving the result.
2. If test POSITIVE for COVID-19, regardless of vaccination status, isolate for at least 5 days by remaining home, away from others as much as possible.
3. If no symptoms, you may end isolation after day 5.
4. If you had symptoms, end isolation after day 5 if your symptoms are improving and you are fever free for a minimum of 24 hours (without the use of fever-reducing medication), but wear a mask through day 10.
5. If you had symptoms and you experienced difficulty breathing or your illness is severe, isolate through day 10 and consult your physician.



In-Building Expectations

1. Wash hands and/or use hand sanitizer often.
2. Consider wearing masks if you are feeling unwell.
3. Masks are available at all entrances to the building.
4. Over the Counter (OTC) COVID-19 tests are available to staff and students in the nurse's office.
