We collected over 1200 canned and boxed foods that went food pantries/shelters in Newark, Irvington, Hillside, and East Orange. The team donating the most food was Team Bridges, with 408 cans and boxes. Link will provide them with a classroom holiday party. Team Chisholm came in second, with 224 and Team King, with 211.

Students prepared 215 sandwich bags (sandwiches, chips, water, and fruit) for the Apostles House and YMCA Emergency Housing in Newark. They also wrote "caring cards" to be sent to an organization that will see that children in foster care receive them.
