NJ State law mandates testing for tuberculosis for all school employees. (NJ Laws 6:29-2.3, 18-A:16-2 and 18A 40-16)

Those required to be tested are newly-hired teachers (full and part time), student teachers, and staff members who have contact with students.

An employee who has had a Mantoux Tuberculin Skin Test administered within the previous six months does not have to be retested, but must submit a copy of the results to the school nurse.

An employee transferring to Link from another school within New Jersey and who had Mantoux Tuberculin Skin Test upon his or her initial employment in a school, does not have to be retested, but must submit a copy of the results to the current school's nurse.

If you have not had a Mantoux Tuberculin Skin Test, you will need to have it administered immediately. Please ask your physician or clinic to complete the form below.
