# **HELP LINK RECRUIT STUDENTS FOR '24-25**

Please spread the word about Link to your friends and families and urge them to apply before March 11. They can do so through the Link website, which connects them to the Newark Common App site. We seek students in all grades, especially kindergarten, first, and fifth. To enter kindergarten, children must be five years old before October 1.

**Note:** Link has a referral program. If you refer a family to Link and the child enrolls and remains at the school, in October, you will receive the choice of a \$30 cash card or gift card to Flynn O'Hara. Gifts cards will be distributed after the new student completes 30 days at Link.

# 5<sup>TH</sup> GRADE HEALTH ALERT: IMMUNIZATIONS DUE SEPTEMBER 1, 2024

The State of New Jersey requires that all students entering 6th grade and born on or after January 1, 1997, receive one booster dose of the tetanus, diphtheria, and pertussis (Tdap) vaccine and one dose of meningococcal vaccine. Documentation from your physician or clinic needs to be on file with Link's School Nurse by the first day of school in September 2024 or your child may be excluded from school. We encourage you to make an appointment for your child to have this immunization well before the start of school in the fall so your child will not be excluded from
